

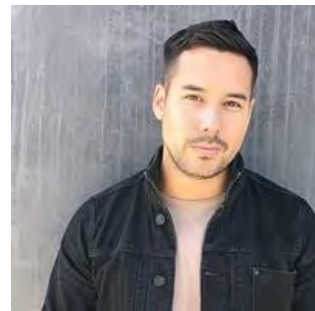

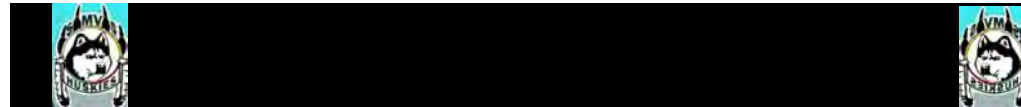

STAY SAFE

STAY SAFE AND AVOID FROSTBITE; BUT IF IT HAPPENS:

Remove any cold clothing that is covering the affected area.
Put your child in dry, warm clothing or cover with blankets.
Slowly warm up the area by gently covering it with your hand.
You may use lukewarm (not hot) water to slowly warm affected body parts.
If your child's hand is frostbitten, place it in her opposite armpit to warm.
Do not massage frostbitten skin. Do not rub snow on frostbitten skin.
Do not use a hot bath, heating pad, heat lamp, or heat from a stove or fireplace to warm affected areas.
Seek medical attention immediately if your child's skin is white, waxy, or feels numb.

Along with the Bingo on November 14th, funds and fun were raised to support the annual all school ski trip that includes all students able to participate.

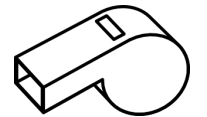
