

In the summer of 2017, Lac La Ronge Indian Band (LLRIB) signed a collaboration agreement with Cameco Corporation. As part of this agreement, Cameco is contributing \$50,000.00 on annual basis matching contributions from LLRIB. LLRIB will contribute \$50,000.00. Kitsaki Management Limited Partnership will also contribute \$50,000.00, for a total of \$150,000.00 to be awarded to eligible full-time students, in attendance during the 2025-2026 academic year. The LLRIB scholarship program has been in existence since 2003 with limited funds. LLRIB is very pleased that the scholarship program has significantly increased to provide support to our students

Patsy Roberts-Head Memorial Scholarship

(Administrative Scholarship)

Deadline for submitting scholarship application is September 15, 2026



Patsy Roberts-Head started her work for the Lac La Ronge Indian Band in 1974. She began as a student, during the early stages of program development. Over the years she held many positions as a Receptionist, Accounting Clerk, Welfare Clerk, Band Councillor, Electoral Officer, and as the Director of Administration. In a brief retirement she sat on the Justice, PSSSP and Housing Committees and also sat as the Elder for the ICFS Board. She ended her work in the Education Department as the Financial Comptroller. During her years with the Band, she worked with different leadership, Directors and employees and developed many lifetime friendships. Of the jobs that she had with the band; she found the work she did to help others the most satisfying. Patsy had a strong work ethic and was deeply respected by many people

throughout the communities in the Lac La Ronge Indian Band area. Patsy lived a humble life, and had an unconditional love for her family and her extended family. She encouraged others to never give up on their dreams and to keep going no matter what they were going through in life. Her calm presence and warm hugs gave strength to others and her caring personality provided support to many. The respect she had for the people of Lac La Ronge Indian Band showed in the 50 years of work and dedication she provided to them during her lifetime.

This scholarship recipient will show a determination to finishing their program and have a commitment towards the betterment of lives for the people within the communities of LLRIB.

How to apply

Applicants must submit:

- Completed scholarship application.
- Post-Secondary transcripts.
- Acceptance letter from Post-Secondary Institution for the 2026-2027 academic year;
- Names and contact information for 2 references and letters (one academic); and
- Cover letter.

All continuing LLRIB full-time Post-Secondary students may apply for one of the 25 scholarships of \$2,500 based on transcripts from the 2025-2026 academic year. Year 4 students who have completed their program are ineligible to apply.



Criteria for the Patsy Roberts-Head Memorial Scholarship is as follows: academic grades for the fall and winter semesters, special significance of program enrolled in, volunteer work, leadership, financial need, and special circumstances in overcoming adversity. All awards will require a completed application with 2 reference letters (one academic).

Note:

***The above scholarship is awarded annually in September for the previous academic year.**

***Scholarships are for full-time students only.**

FOR ALL ELIGIBLE LAC LA RONGE INDIAN BAND MEMBERS ONLY

Eligible students may apply to all scholarship programs; however, a student will only be awarded one scholarship annually.
