

In the summer of 2017, Lac La Ronge Indian Band (LLRIB) signed a collaboration agreement with Cameco Corporation. As part of this agreement, Cameco is contributing \$50,000.00 on annual basis matching contributions from LLRIB. LLRIB will contribute \$50,000.00. Kitsaki Management Limited Partnership will also contribute \$50,000.00, for a total of \$150,000.00 to be awarded to eligible full-time students, in attendance during the 2025-2026 academic year. The LLRIB scholarship program has been in existence since 2003 with limited funds. LLRIB is very pleased that the scholarship program has significantly increased to provide support to our students.

(Medical Field Scholarship)

Shantal Mirasty is a member of the Lac La Ronge Indian Band and a Registered Nurse who convocated at the University of Saskatchewan in 2019. Shantal found time for community involvement while attending University of Saskatchewan she worked in Group Homes for Youth and Elders on evenings and weekends. Shantal's character is grounded in humour, joy, love, and she was a firm believer of responsibility and with the love, kindness, honesty, integrity, self-sacrifice, common sense and moral standards to lead by example. After receiving her Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 2021, Shantal accepted a position at St. Paul's Hospital in Saskatoon. Then Shantal accepted a position with SIIT as an Instructor for the Indigenous Practical Nursing Program in Saskatoon. Shantal was always grateful of her LLRIB Post-Secondary funding and pursued her career in Nursing.

Shantal embodied the true spirit of selflessness and humility. Shantal was a dedicated Mother and Wife but she also dedicated her time preparing Turkey Meals on Christmas Day and handing out to the less fortunate.

How to apply

Applicants must submit:

- Completed scholarship application.
- Post-Secondary transcripts.
- Acceptance letter from Post-Secondary Institution for the 2026-2027 academic year;
- Names and contact information for 2 references and letters (one academic): and
- Cover letter.

All continuing LLRIB full-time Post-Secondary students may apply for one of the 25 scholarships of \$2,500 based on transcripts from the 2025-2026 academic year. Year 4 students who have completed their program are ineligible to apply.



Criteria for the Shantal Mirasty Memorial Scholarship is as follows: academic grades for the fall and winter semesters, special significance of program enrolled in, volunteer work, leadership, financial need, and special circumstances in overcoming adversity. All awards will require a completed application with 2 reference letters (one academic).

Note:

***The above scholarship is awarded annually in September for the previous academic year.**

***Scholarships are for full-time students only.**

FOR ALL ELIGIBLE LAC LA RONGE INDIAN BAND MEMBERS ONLY

Eligible students may apply to all scholarship programs; however, a student will only be awarded one scholarship annually.
